What is HHW?

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) refers to leftover household products that may be flammable, toxic, corrosive or reactive.

Improper handling of these materials can pose risk to human health and the environment.

Why does it matter?

These materials should never be placed in the trash or poured down drains. Proper disposal helps protect, people, wildlife, and local water systems.

What can you do?

- Never throw HHW items in the trash.
- Never mix products.
- Keep HHW in their original containers.
- Ensure materials are clearly labeled.
